By combining facial recognition and fingerprint authentication with the KidsKount Kiosk and Pocket PC, adults quickly register their children, and gain access to your facility, all in less than 10 seconds. Most importantly, KidsKount provides you with the peace-of-mind that no child will be released to the wrong person while in your care.

KidsKount Utilizes Biometrics



All parents and adults on the pick-up list are fingerprinted and photographed. Each time they enter your building, access is permitted to the children's area by utilizing KidsKount. KidsKount uses fingerprint and facial recognition to verify identity and register the drop-off/pick-up process. No pin codes for them to remember and share with others, no bar coded cards to forget or lose. They simply walk to the KidsKount Kiosk, place their finger on the scanner, observe the touchscreen, select drop-off or pick-up, select the child's photo and entry is gained. Biometrics makes this process fast and easy while providing accuracy and reliability.

KidsKount includes Pocket PC Mobility



The KidsKount Kiosk sends the photos and data to the staff Pocket PC, wirelessly. This enables the staff to move freely throughout your facility, yet be readily available to receive and dismiss children. The Pocket PC displays the adult and child photos for easy identification. The Pocket PC also comes with a camera that automatically snaps a photo of the staff member who is operating the PC. By combining the Kiosk with the Pocket PC, KidsKount tracks the identity of every person involved with the pick-up/drop-off process.

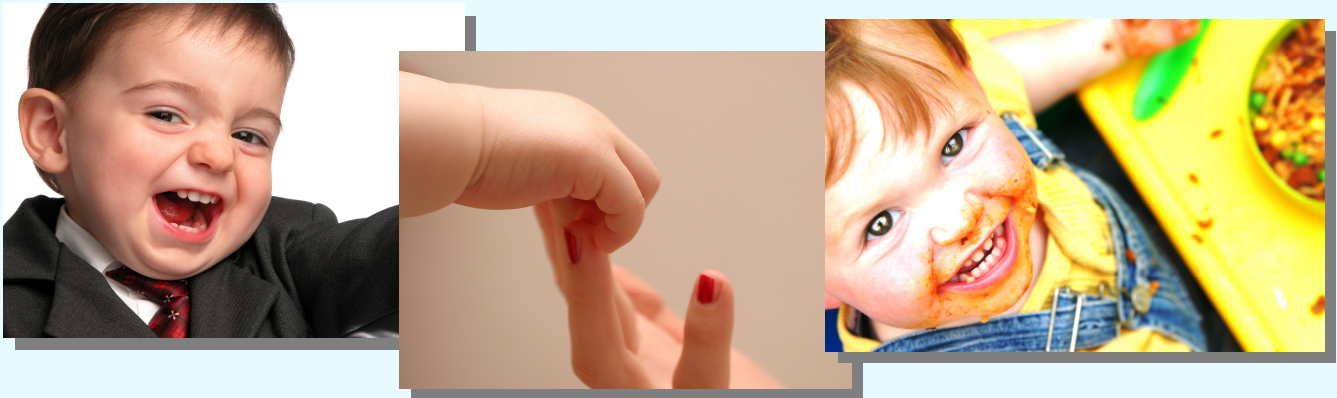

KidsKount is Easy to Use!

- During enrollment, every parent (adult) and child is entered into the system, including fingerprint and photo, creating a personal record.
- Parent enters building, placing finger on KidsKount Kiosk scanner. KidsKount discreetly snaps parent's photo, while comparing fingerprint and facial recognition to the record. If verification is accurate, KidsKount displays registration screen on the touchscreen. (In case of false identity, door remains locked, parent is classified as unauthorized and staff is alerted via Pocket PC).
- Using the Kiosk screen, the parent selects drop-off or pick-up, selects photo of child and selects the 'done' icon. Door unlocks, enabling adult to enter children's area. (Process to this point has taken less than 15 seconds.)
- KidsKount Pocket PC automatically displays the proper record of parent entering the children's area, along with parent and child's photo and registration information to staff.
- Staff visually matches parent's photo with person, matches child's photo with child, selects the parent's and child's photos, then selects "accepted or released". The Pocket PC has discreetly photographed the staff member and recorded all information including date and time.
- The KidsKount process is complete.



“My child is missing! Who picked him up? Who did you release him to?”

If you are responsible for answering these questions, you will quickly appreciate what KidsKount can do for you! First, and foremost, using the KidsKount record log you will be able to print out all the information pertinent to the child such as name, photo, height, weight, medical information, and the time and date the child was released. Furthermore, KidsKount will provide you with the exact identity of the adult that picked up the child and the staff member responsible for the release. The adult's fingerprint, latest photo, name, address, phone number, and relationship to the child is already on file and can easily be supplied to the parents and the proper authorities to assist them in their search.

Second, KidsKount will provide the evidence you need to prove your facility followed proper release procedure. This valuable feature is paramount when defending your business practices in a court of law.

Parts and Pieces

KidsKount is made up of a Kiosk (floor, wall or shelf mounted) located in the entryway and a Pocket PC for the staff. Parents use their fingerprint to register their children and gain door access. The Kiosk transmits all the data, including photos, to the staff Pocket PC via wireless transmission. You can equip every room with a Pocket PC or just one for the entire staff depending on your needs. By selecting the appropriate photo displayed on the Pocket PC, the staff can accept or release children from your facility. KidsKount also tabulates a roster of children currently in-house, while providing an accurate headcount for any given period. In case of an emergency, you know exactly which child is missing.

Installation

Applied Computer Systems, Inc. offers onsite installation at your facilities. The installation process will include permanent installation and training of your personnel. KidsKount may be installed by the end user if desired. Toll-free technical support will be furnished during the installation process.

Warranty

KidsKount PC, wireless equipment and touchscreen are covered by a one year warranty. All peripherals are under warranty for a ninety day period.
